Waco Lake closes park areas due to flooding

FORT WORTH, Texas – Due to current flooding conditions, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Waco Lake announced today that all parks and boat ramps are closed indefinitely. The closures apply to all recreation facilities, roads, and boat ramps. As these facilities dry out, any needed repairs will be made and areas reopened. Swimming and boating are not recommended due to underwater hazards such as submerged roads, signs, structures, stumps and land formations as well as debris floating in the lake. Partial area and boat ramp openings may begin by late June. For more information, please call the lake office at 254-756-5359.
