Corps of Engineers, Waco Lake, opens several park areas

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District, has opened several park areas at Waco Lake. The park areas were closed due to flooding but through volunteer efforts and contract services, the following parks will be reopened this weekend for use. Opening today are Midway Park and Speegleville Park campgrounds. Opening Saturday are Twin Bridges, Airport Beach, Koehne Park, Midway Park and Speegleville Park boat ramps and Twin Bridges Beach and picnic area. In addition, Bosque Park, Dam Hike and Bike Trail, Flat Rock boat ramp, Woodway Park, Ridgewood Marina, Waco Wetlands, and Speegleville Marina with dock access only will be opened.
