Shenango Seeks Volunteers for Keep America Beautiful Cleanup

<u>SHENANGO RIVER LAKE</u> – The Shenango River Lake staff is seeking volunteers for litter pick-up at Shenango Lake recreation and access areas. This annual cleanup is being conducted on Saturday, April 21, in conjunction with Keep America Beautiful's *2007 Great American Cleanup*. Individuals or groups are invited to be part of this effort. Join your neighbors and the Shenango River Lake staff in helping to cleanup our lake area.

Children under 18 must be supervised by an adult and care should be exercised by all to avoid picking up potentially hazardous objects or materials. Volunteers can obtain an Activities Hazard Analysis, which will discuss the potential hazards and precautions to take when performing clean up activities, from the Shenango staff prior to the event.
