## Wallisville Lake Project accepting Duck Blind applications

In preparation for the 2008-2009 Waterfowl season, the Wallisville Lake Project is currently accepting applications for its seasonal duck blind program. Duck blind applications shall be made on a white 3" X 5" note or index card with the following information.

- Name as it appears on Driver's License or State ID Card
- Address as it appears on Driver's License or State ID Card, with city and zip
- Both daytime and nighttime phone numbers
- Driver's License or State ID number

Complete one card per application only. Application cards will be accepted at the Wallisville Lake Project Office through June 30, 2008. If hand delivered, cards must be at the Project Office before the close of business at 4:00 p.m. on June 30. If cards are mailed, make sure that the postmark is dated no later than June 30.

Duck blind applications sent to the Galveston District Office **will not** be accepted at any time. If selected in the random drawing, hunters will be notified by mail when to come to the Project Office to choose a duck blind location.
