coordination/implementation of major hydropower initiatives, consistent
with the Corps_ hydropower mission. Responsible for managing quality
assurance of hydropower data that is reported to the Operations &
Maintenance (O&M) Business Information Link database. Participates as
necessary in inspections of power plants. Participates in preparation
of the operation & maintenance budget for hydropower business line.
Responsible for development & justification of Hydropower Program
budget for all 75 hydropower projects. Monitors execution of Hydropower
Program during current year, making allowance requests based upon field
submittals. National proponent & instructor for command training
courses in hydropower operations.
