Ice Harbor Visitor Center to open April 1

Burbank, Wash. – The Ice Harbor Visitor Center will be open to the public at 9 a.m. April 1. Visitors will be required to park outside the gate and need to check in with the guard upon entering. The visitor center will be open seven days a week, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

For safety reasons, backpacks, purses, cameras, cell phones, water bottles and diaper bags will not be allowed in the facility. All adults must have photo identification with them. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

The opening of campgrounds along the Snake River will be delayed due to upgrades. Hood Park, Charbonneau Park, Fishhook Park, Windust Park and Levey Day Use Area will open on May 1.
