Corps announces boat launch annual passes now available

Walla Walla, Wash. – The Walla Walla District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announces that boat launch passes are now available. The passes are only good for boat ramps that are managed by the Corps.

The new passes are on a hang tag and can be switched from one vehicle to another if owned by the same household. The passes are good for an entire year from date of purchase.

The price for the passes is \$30 or a day-use fee of \$3. Purchases can be made by mail or in person from Corps' Natural Resource Offices in Clarkston, Wash., and in Boise, Idaho. They are also available from Corps park rangers during the recreation season.

Passes from Boise can be purchased at the Lucky Peak Dam and Lake Office, 9723 E Hwy 21, Boise, ID 83716, during business hours of 7:30 a.m. – 4 p.m., Monday – Friday. People with Golden Age Access Cards and Golden Access Cards pay only \$15.

Passes from Clarkston can be purchased at the Clarkston Natural Resources Office, 100 Fair Street, Clarkston, WA 99403, during business hours of 7:30 a.m. – 4 p.m., Monday – Friday.
