Dworshak recreation staffers offer updated facilities information

Orofino, Idaho, – Enjoy beautiful north-central Idaho at any of several facilities operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers which are open for the summer 2005 recreation season at Dworshak Reservoir.

Camping with full hook-up sites is available at Dent Campground for \$16 per night. Reservations can be made by calling (877) 444-6777, or by visiting the website at <u>www.ReserveUSA.com</u>. All sites are booked for Memorial Day weekend. With the reservoir within 5 inches of being full, mini-camps are available on a first-come, first-served basis along the shoreline. Grandad, Dam View and Canyon Creek campgrounds are also available on a first-come, first-served basis. There is no charge for using these primitive camps. All boat ramps are open and available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. For updated water level and boat ramp information, call (800) 321-3198 or (208) 476-1255. When boating on the reservoir, please use caution because lake levels can change quickly. Always wear a Coast Guard-approved personal flotation device.
