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# Corps seeks comments for amending lock operations at Bonneville Dam and restricted area changes at Little Goose 

WALLA WALLA, Wash. - The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers invites public comments on its prop osal to amend the regulations for lockage operations at Bonneville Lock and Dam and to amend the regulations which establish the restricted areas at Little Goose Lock and Dam.

The Corps built a new replacement lock for Bonneville Lock and Dam and now wants to update regulation language to reflect the corrections and adjustments to the lockage control, signals and permissible dimensions of vessels.

At Little Goose Lock and Dam, the Corps plans to make adjustments in the upstream channel restricted area boundary to provide a recreational craft corridor along the north shoreline. This will provide better boat ramp access in support of the small watercraft portage route and reduce interference between fisherman and the ramp.
