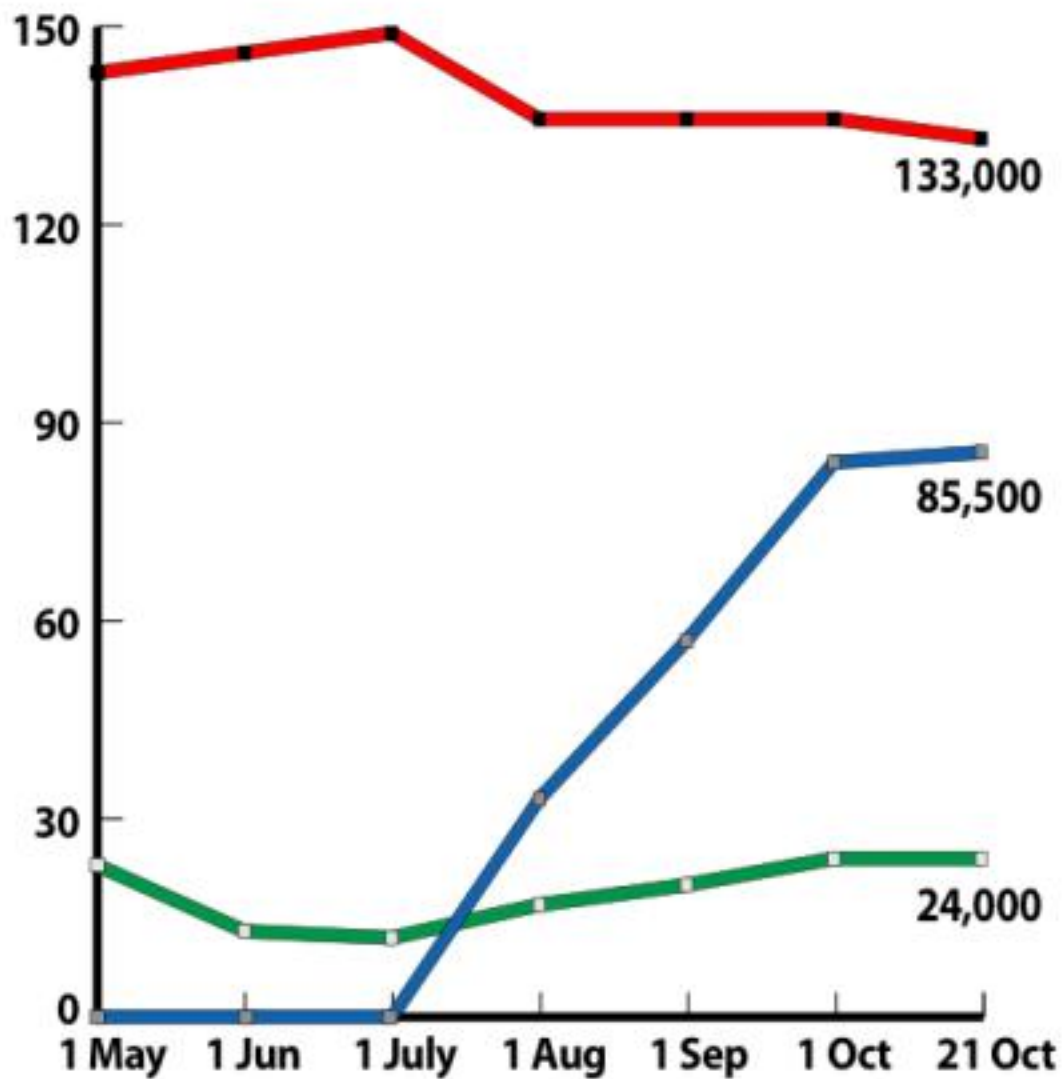

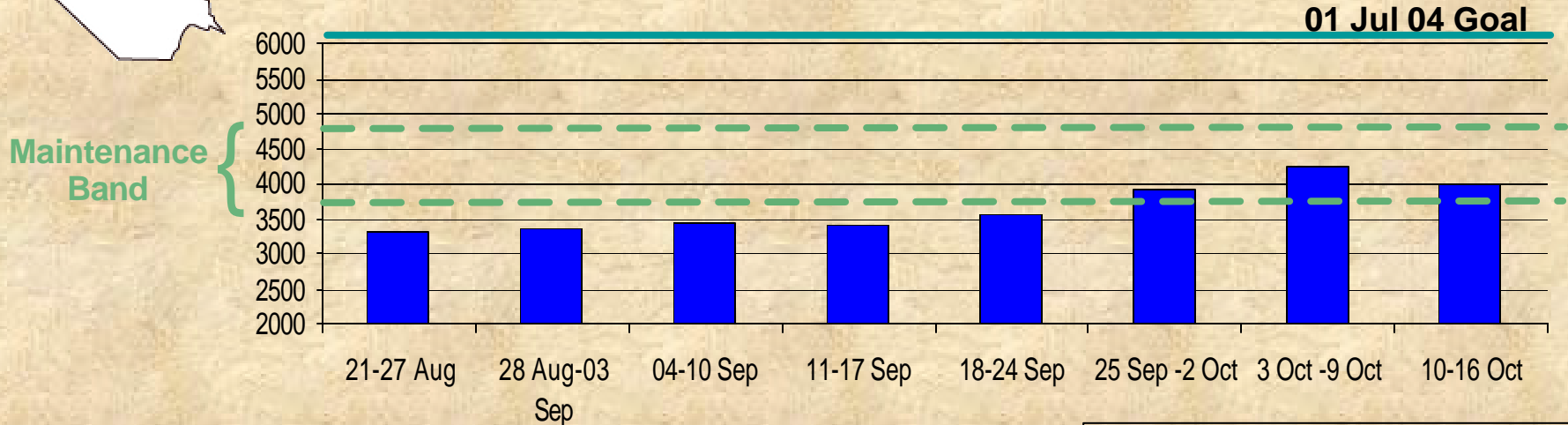

## Power



### Electrical Generation

Pre-War	3,300 Megawatts (MW)
01 May 03	200 MW
21 Sep 03	3,678 MW
05 Oct 03	4,417 MW (met initial goal of 4,400 MW)



- Autumn Overhaul / Outage Program began 13 Oct 03 and ends Mar 04. Estimated power production range during this period is 3,800-4,800 MW as generators are taken off line for maintenance, currently 400MW offline for scheduled maintenance
- TF-Restore Iraqi Electricity is tracking 26 Power Generation, Transmission, and Management Control Projects worth \$1.1 Billion. 23 of 26 projects are started



## Crude Oil Production

- Pre-War Peak: 2.500M BPD in Feb 03
- Post-War Peak: 2.099M BPD (12 Oct 03)
- 7-day Daily Average: 2.030M BPD
- Iraq Domestic Need / Storage: 0.921M BPD
- Mid-Term Target (Jan 04): 2.000M BPD (2002 Pre-War Avg)
- Long-Term Target (Dec 04): 3.000M BPD (Pre-War Capacity)

## Education

### Functioning Educational Institutions

- 01 Oct: Primary and secondary schools opened to approximately 5.5 million students
  - 02 Oct: Mosul University graduates 2,200 students
  - 20 Major Universities
  - 43 Technical Schools
- } Graduated 3,400 students in 2003

} Includes repair / replacement of doors, windows, restroom facilities; generally no major reconstruction or new construction

### Impact on Employment

- Primary Schools employ 160,000 and Secondary Schools 62,000 teachers
- 35,000+ Iraqis (64 Iraqi subcontractors) working to rehabilitate 1,500 schools. USAID contractors developed methodology to select schools

## Health Care

### Milestones

- Oct 03: Achieve 100% of pre-war level of healthcare throughout Iraq
- EOY 03: 70-80% national coverage for children's immunizations
- FY 04: Update medical technologies and fix infrastructure/equipment



### Current Activities

- Kirkuk Governing Council coordinating with Turkish and Iraqi Red Crescent to build and operate a city hospital
- Installation of generators 75% complete at six hospitals
  - Program on course to install 128 generators and 10 uninterrupted power supply units throughout Baghdad this year
  - \$40 million initiative
- 17 Iraqi children receive specialized medical care in Germany
  - MEDEVAC by US Air Force from Baghdad on 05 Oct to Ramstein Air Base

- 33 Coalition Countries currently providing ~24,000 personnel
- Coalition Forces are conducting over 1,600 patrols per day
- Only ~1/10 of 1% of patrols result in US casualties
- Took an average of 78 detainees per day in the past week
- 11,000 Iraqi Security Forces in training



## Milestones

- **19 Sep: Council of Judges established to supervise judicial and prosecutorial systems (began 04 Oct) - provides independent judiciary**
- **Oct: Constitutional Prep Committee submits a report with three options to choose Convention - favors direct election of representatives**
- **Next 90 days: Enhanced capacity for elections; determine method to choose Constitutional Convention**

## International Recognition

- **16 Oct: The United Nations Security Council approves a resolution inviting the Governing Council to submit a timetable by 15 Dec for drafting a new constitution and holding democratic elections**
- **17 Oct: 108 Iraqi delegates attend Madrid Donors' Conference**



## Financial Markets

- Rafidain and Rasheed Banks reopen over 280 branches across the country
- Satellite voice and data systems for Rafidain, Rasheed, and Central Bank will be installed by the end of Oct at 80 locations, enhancing communications
- New Central Bank begins currency auction
- Central Bank begins more rigorous supervision of Iraqi Banks

## Private Sector Development

- World Bank proposes facility for small business development to include \$30M for technical assistance and \$70-100M for investment financing
- CPA to award \$15M for National Micro and Small Enterprise Credit Program

## Currency Exchange

- Ongoing in approximately 250 bank branches
- Began 15 Oct; completion date is 15 Jan 04
- Approximately 2 billion banknotes expected to be exchanged
