**INSTRUCTIONS
TO ALL PERSONS OF
JAPANESE
ANCESTRY**
Living in the Following Area:

All that portion of the City of San Francisco, from the above designated streets to the north and south of the street designated by the above streets, and between the streets designated by the above streets, as shown on the attached map, in the area of the City of San Francisco.

All Japanese persons, both alien and American, will be required to live in the above designated area by 12:00 o'clock noon Pacific, April 1, 1942.

No Japanese person will be permitted to enter or leave the above designated area after 12:00 noon Pacific, April 1, 1942, without obtaining special permission from the Bureau of War Relocation at the Civil Control Administration, 1200 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California.

The Civil Control Administration is required to accept the Japanese population affected by this instruction in the following areas:

1. Civil affairs and instructions on the evacuation.
2. Property and business matters in connection with the evacuation, including the sale, lease, or other disposition of real and personal property.
3. Health inspection and treatment for all Japanese in health groups.
4. Transport and other matters in connection with the evacuation of these areas.

The Following Instructions Must Be Observed:

1. A responsible member of each family, preferably the head of the family, or the person in charge of the family, shall register the family with the Civil Control Administration, 1200 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California, by 12:00 noon Pacific, April 1, 1942.
2. Evacuation must comply with the instructions for the evacuation of the following areas:
 - (a) Housing and business (see instructions for each member of the family).
 - (b) Public utilities for each member of the family.
 - (c) Evacuation of the family to the evacuation center.
 - (d) All other matters, including business, health and other matters of the family.
 - (e) Essential personal effects for each member of the family.

All items carried will be searched, packaged and placed under seal with the name of the owner and number of packages in duplicate for the use of the Civil Control Administration. The name and number of packages in duplicate for the use of the Civil Control Administration. No unregistered items as described in paragraph 1, Public Proclamation No. 1, Department of War, Western Defense Command and Fourth Army, dated March 28, 1942, will be carried.

The Civil Control Administration through its agents will provide for the storage of the suit and trunk of the owner of the above mentioned household items, such as clothing, bedding, appliances, papers and other items. Clothing, bedding and other small items will be accepted if stored, packed and placed under seal with the name and address of the owner. This suit and trunk will be used for a given family.

1. Each family and individual living there, will be furnished transportation to the evacuation center. Personal transportation will not be allowed. All transportation pertaining to the evacuation will be obtained at the Civil Control Administration.

On the Civil Control Administration of 1200 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California, between 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. Thursday, April 2, 1942, or between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Friday, April 3, 1942, to receive further instructions.

Civilian Exclusion Order No. 5

1. That the portion of the City of San Francisco, from the above designated streets to the north and south of the street designated by the above streets, and between the streets designated by the above streets, as shown on the attached map, in the area of the City of San Francisco, is hereby excluded from the evacuation of the Japanese population affected by this instruction in the following areas:

1. Civil affairs and instructions on the evacuation.
2. Property and business matters in connection with the evacuation, including the sale, lease, or other disposition of real and personal property.
3. Health inspection and treatment for all Japanese in health groups.
4. Transport and other matters in connection with the evacuation of these areas.

The following instructions must be observed:
