

DIRECTIONS

PINEY GROVE CAMPGROUND RULES


Please obey the following rules so that everyone can enjoy Piney Grove Campground:

- * Must be 18 or older to rent campsite.
- * Fires are allowed in grills and fire rings only. Please do not leave them unattended. Completely extinguish all fires before leaving.
- * Pets must be penned, caged, or on a leash under 6 feet in length. No pets are allowed on the beach or in restrooms. Please dispose of all pet wastes properly.
- * Visitor hours are 6:00 a.m. 9:00 p.m. Sightseeing hours are 10:00 a.m. 6:00 p.m. during spring and summer months.
- * Quiet hours are 10:00 p.m. 6:00 a.m. Gates will be locked during these hours. Please have children on the site during these hours.
- * America the Beautiful/Golden Age/Access cardholders can only pay for nights they occupy a site.
- * Camping is allowed only in designated sites and areas, and is limited to 14 days in any 30-day period.
- * Fireworks are not permitted at any time.
- * Vehicles must stay on authorized roadways at all times. Parking is restricted to designated areas.
- * Tents, boat trailers, vehicles, and similar equipment must be placed on the impact pads and are not allowed off the impact area.
- * Only "street legal" vehicles are allowed in campground.
- * No bottles or glass are allowed on the beach.
- * No washing of vehicles or campers in campground.
- * The discharge of gray water is not allowed. Please dispose of all gray water at the dump station.
- * Do not carve, chop, cut, or damage any live trees. Only dead wood on the ground may be collected for firewood.
- * Please keep site clean and litter-free during stay and remove all personal equipment and clean site before departing. All garbage must be disposed of at the dumpsters.

The above rules are listed as a supplement to Title 36, "Rules and Regulations", and in no way supersedes the wording of "Title 36". The above rules are subject to change. A complete set of rules is located at the gatehouse.



PINEY GROVE CAMPGROUND is a "Class-

A" facility. Each site has a impact pad, picnic table, grill, fire ring, lantern post, water and electrical hookups. Additional facilities include: boat ramp, playgrounds, multi-use game courts, picnic shelter, restrooms with showers, laundry building, trailer dump station, fish cleaning station, an amphitheater for seasonal weekend programs, and a nearby beach. The beach is open seasonally, but no lifeguards are provided. The restrooms and several of the campsites are handicapped-accessible.

Registered campers may use any day-use facility on the Waterway without charge.

For those of you who really want to get back to nature there is Pinev Grove Primitive **Campground.** Ten campsites with impact pads, picnic tables, and grills are available at no charge. Only accessible by boat, there is no water or electrical hookups. Title 36 rules do apply.
