DIVIDE OVERLOOK RECREATION AREA

Divide Overlook Recreation Area is operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. This area is located in Tishomingo County just off of MS Highway 364 on the east side of the Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway. The area gets its name from the cut that was made through the divide ridge that turned water into the Tennessee River on one side and Mackies Creek on the other. The park is located near the deepest excavation "cut". The cut was 175 feet deep. This area contains a restroom, one small covered shelter, and an observation area. This area does not have power or water.

This shelter has 2 tables and 1 grill with an average capacity of 16-20 people.
