HOLCUT MEMORIAL PARK

Holcut Memorial Park is operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Holcut was the only community acquired for the construction of the Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway. Holcut Memorial is located in Tishomingo County on the east side of the Waterway at the end of MS Highway 364. The park has one covered shelter, a waterborne restroom, five picnic sites and a memorial listing former Holcut residents.
