STENNIS EAST BANK RECREATION AREA

Stennis East Bank Recreation Area is operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and is located in Lowndes County, Mississippi on the Tennessee-Tombigbee, just off of US Highway 45, at Columbus, Mississippi. The park is adjacent to Stennis Lock and Dam. Facilities include a boat ramp, three fishing piers, a fish cleaning station, two multi-use courts, a walking track, play areas, an amphitheater and three large covered shelters. Columbus Marina and a restaurant are located nearby. Other single covered picnic tables with grills are also available. Gates to the area open at 6 a.m. – the boat ramp is open 24-hours.
