Dashiels L/D, Ohio River, Mile 13.3  
Renovate Middle Wall Filling & Emptying Valves and Operating  
Machinery in the 110' x 600' Lock Chamber

1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will make repairs to the middle wall filling and emptying valves and operating machinery in the 110' x 600' lock chamber at Dashiels L/D, Ohio River. The valves repairs are scheduled to begin at 1:00 A.M. on March 2, 2004 and will be completed by 8:00 A.M. on March 23, 2004.

2. The 110' x 600' land chamber will be closed intermittently during the scheduled work periods. Closures up to four hours will be incurred on the first and last day of the job in order to install and remove valve bulkheads. Additional closures up to four hours will be incurred periodically during the job to move valve blades, parts and equipment.

3. The 56' x 360' river chamber will be closed during this work period. The Repair Fleet will be moored in the small lock and will perform as much work as possible there to minimize the closures of the large 110' x 600' lock chamber.

4. General wear and deterioration of the valves has made it necessary to schedule this work.

5. Navigators are requested to use caution while using the large lock chamber.
