Morgantown Lock and Dam, Monongahela River, Mile 102.0 <u>Replace Land Wall Filling Valve</u> and Renovate Operating Machinery

1. <u>TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN</u>: Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Repair Fleet will be replacing the land wall filling valve and renovating the operating machinery in the single 84' x 600' lock chamber at Morgantown Lock and Dam, Monongahela River. The repair work is scheduled to begin at 8:00 AM on April 19, 2004 and will be completed by 11:00 PM on April 29, 2004.

2. The single $84' \ge 600'$ lock chamber will remain open to traffic during the repair period. Intermittent delays up to 4 hours may be encountered during the renovation work period.

3. General wear and deterioration on the valve has made it necessary to schedule this work.

4. Navigators please note the location and duration of this work and use caution when entering and leaving the lock chamber.
