## Construction Activities on Fort Duquesne Bridge Allegheny River, Mile 0.2

- 1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is given that a contractor for the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation will be performing construction activities on the Fort Duquesne Bridge over the Allegheny River at Mile 0.2 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
- 2. The work will be performed from April through September 2004 and 2005.
- 3. Construction activities will include cleaning and painting of the entire steel superstructure, expansion dam repairs, and miscellaneous structural repairs. None of the repairs will permanently reduce horizontal or vertical clearance over the Allegheny River.
- 4. During painting of the main span, the vertical clearance will be temporarily decreased to approximately 40 feet.
- 5. The contractor may use barges to collect and transfer blast waste. These will be placed to minimize impact on navigation.
- 6. Navigators, please use caution in and around the area.
