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New Cumberland Locks and Dam, Ohio River, Mile 54.3  
Repairs to the Land Wall Emptying Valve in  
the 110' X 600' Land Lock Chamber

1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' will make repairs to the land wall emptying valve in the 110' x 600' land chamber at New Cumberland Locks and Dam, Ohio River. Work is scheduled to begin at 8:00 A.M. on October 18, 2004 and will be completed by 11:00 P.M. on November 2, 2004.
2. The 110' x 600' land chamber will be closed to all navigation during this work period. The 110' x 1200' river chamber will be available to navigation during the work period. Intermittent delays to navigation are expected.
3. Damage to the seal on this valve has made it necessary to schedule this work at New Cumberland. Repairs to the river wall filling valve at Pike Island L/D, originally scheduled during this time period, have been cancelled and will be rescheduled at a later date.
4. Navigators please note the location and duration of this work and use caution when entering and leaving the river lock chamber.
