## <u>Schedule of Operations</u> Allegheny River Locks

- 1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is given for the normal fall schedule at Locks 2 through 9, Allegheny River, as follows:
- a. Locks 7, 8, and 9, Allegheny River Effective October 18, 2004, Locks 7, 8, and 9 will be **closed** for the season.
- b. Lock 6, Allegheny River Effective October 18, 2004, Lock 6 will operate 7:30 A.M. to 3:10 P.M., daily.
- c. Lock 5, Allegheny River Effective October 18, 2004, Lock 5 will operate 7:30 A.M. to 3:10 P.M., daily.
- d. <u>Locks 2 through 4, Allegheny River</u> Locks 2 through 4, Allegheny River, will continue to operate 24 hours <u>daily</u>.
- 2. Commercial operators desiring lockage at other than regular operating periods must make arrangements at least 24 hours in advance during the hours of 7:30 A.M. to 3:00 P.M., Monday through Friday, at the Ohio-Allegheny Rivers Area Office, (412) 395-7650.
- 3. <u>Special Note</u>: Because of limited staffing, no lockages will be made between 11:00 P.M. and 6:30 A.M. at Locks 5 through 9. No appointments will be accepted for lockages that would occur during this 7-1/2 hour period.
- 4. This notice will be updated, as required.
