New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River, Mile 54.3
Drilling and Sampling Work in Downstream 1200-ft Lock Chamber Approach

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that a contractor for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will be performing drilling and sampling at New Cumberland L/D, Mile 54.3, Ohio River. Drilling and sampling will be done in the downstream 1200-ft lock approach between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M., Thursday and Friday, August 4-5, 2005.
2. Due to the scheduled closure and dewatering of the 600-ft lock chamber (by the Corps' Repair Fleet) at the time of the drilling and sampling activity, the contractor will be required to move out of the 1200-ft lock approach area to allow traffic to pass. Only minor delays to navigation are expected.
3. Navigators please note the location and duration of the drilling and sampling equipment and use extra care when maneuvering near the contractor's fleet. This drilling and sampling activity is necessary to prepare for future dredging in the downstream approach to the lock.
