Captina Bank Stabilization and Restoration

Ohio River, Left Bank, Mile 107.7

Marshall County, WV

1. <u>To All Whom It May Concern:</u> Notice is given that Madison Coal & Supply Company of Charleston, West Virginia, under contract with the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Huntington District, will be placing riverbank protection along the left bank of the Ohio River at Mile 107.7, from the confluence of Fish Run 400 feet upriver, on the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service's Captina Mainland property in Marshall County, West Virginia. The work would involve construction of a stone dike, tiebacks, fill and vegetation.

2. The work will be performed during daylight hours, six days a week, beginning on or about November 7, 2005 and ending on or about December 16, 2005.

3. During this work, the M/V TowBoat-Point and 1 Marine Crane with 2 Martial Barges will be on site. These vessels will be kept out of the channel during non-working hours.

4. Navigators, please use caution in and around the area.
