Fort Duquesne Highway Bridge Inspection Allegheny River, River Mile 0.25

1. <u>**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:**</u> Notice is given that at approximately 7:00 A.M. on Friday, March 31, 2006, SAI Engineers (under contract with PADOT, District 11) is scheduled to begin inspections of the main channel span of the Fort Duquesne Highway Bridge, located at Allegheny River Mile 0.25, in Pittsburgh, PA. The work is to be conducted primarily during daylight hours on Friday, March 31st through Wednesday, April 5th. No weekend work is scheduled. Equipment involved in the operations are the towboat M/V Lift Boat and one deck barge mounted with a man lift.

2. As a result of these inspection activities being conducted from the navigation channel, river traffic may experience intermittent delays and are requested to exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
