Braddock Locks and Dam, Monongahela River, Mile 11.3
Five 8-Hour Closures of Main (110-ft x 720-ft) Lock Chamber

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the main 110-ft x 720-ft lock chamber at Braddock L/D, Monongahela River will be closed from 7:30 AM to 3:30 PM on each of the following days: 5,12,20,25 & 30 October 2006. The closures will enable Joseph B. Faye Inc., contractor for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, to place concrete for the downstream middlewall bulkhead recess.

2. During the closures of the main lock chamber, all traffic will be passed through the small 56-ft x 360-ft lock chamber. **Single lockage tow configurations up to 56-ft x 360-ft will only be accommodated during the five 8-hour closures.** The closures and single lockage procedure were developed in cooperation with the Waterways Association of Pittsburgh.
