Lock 4, Monongahela River, Mile 41.5 Replace Middle Wall Emptying Valve and Renovate Operating Machinery in the 56' x 720' Land Lock Chamber

To All Whom It May Concern: Notice is given that the U.S. 1. Army Corps of Engineers' Repair Fleet will renovate the middle wall emptying valve and operating machinery in the 56' x 720' land lock chamber at Lock 4 (Charleroi), Monongahela River. The repair work is scheduled to begin at 1:00 AM on April 13, 2007 and will be completed by 11:00 PM on April 25, 2007.

The 56' x 720' lock chamber will be open to navigation 2. during this repair period; however, closures up to 4-hours will occur periodically (approximately 4 times during the 13-day work period) to move and install valve parts and equipment on the middle wall.

General wear and deterioration of the valve has made it 3. necessary to schedule this work.

Navigators please note the location and duration of this 4. work and use caution when entering or leaving the lock chamber. The Repair Fleet will be moored on the upper and lower river (guard) walls for the duration of the work period.
