Columbia Gas Submarine Transmission Line Repairs Ohio River, Mile 46.9

1. **TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that at approximately 7:00 A.M. on Monday, October 15, 2007, the Ohio River Salvage Company (under contract with Columbia Gas Company) is scheduled to begin replacement of the existing submarine gas transmission line beginning at the left descending bank near the ERGON Petroleum Terminal and proceeding to the Sailing Line of the main channel on the Ohio River, at Mile 46.9. The work will be conducted from Monday through Saturday from 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. daily through November 15, 2007. Equipment involved in the pipeline replacement operations is the towboat Mary Lynn Ann and a derrick boat.

2. All equipment will be relocated to the shoreline at the end of each work day.

3. As the work proceeds within the navigation channel, river traffic may experience intermittent delays and are requested to exercise extreme caution when transiting this area. Standard marine radio frequencies should be monitored when in the vicinity of this construction operation.
