New Mainline Pennsylvania Turnpike Highway Bridge Construction Allegheny River, Mile 14.14

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that Walsh Construction (under contract with the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission) will stage an 80-ft x 80-ft crane barge at a recently constructed cofferdam on the right descending bank at mile 14.1, Allegheny River, just downstream of C.W. Bill Young Lock & Dam. The crane barge will be utilized for work activity in support of the New PA Turnpike Highway Bridge Construction Project.
2. Work will be performed from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, beginning on or about April 28, 2008, and will continue until the completion of the bridge project.
3. For the duration of this work, the crane barge will remain outside the navigation channel and will be lighted at night. For further information, you can contact Mr. Dave Singleton of Walsh Construction at 612-363-4805.
4. Navigators should use caution in and around the area.
