Construction of Limestone Unloading and Empty Barge Storage Area By Monongahela Power Company Monongahela River, Left Bank, Mile 91.7-92.7

- 1. <u>To All Whom It May Concern:</u> Notice is given that Brayman Construction Corporation, contractor for Monongahela Power Company, will be constructing a limestone unloading and empty barge storage area along the left bank of the Monongahela River, Mile 91.7-92.7, in Maidsville, Monongalia County, West Virginia.
- 2. The work will be performed Monday through Friday for 10 hours a day, beginning September 3, 2008 and continuing until completion of work on or about April 1, 2009.
- 3. Initially during this work, there will be one floating plant consisting of: one 50'x150' spud barge w/crane, one 35'x195' material barge, one 30'x150' material barge, one 30'x175' material barge and a 450 horsepower push boat (the Okan). This equipment will be supplemented with an additional floating plant of a 50'x165' spud barge w/crane and a 45'x110' spud barge and crane in mid to late September. Equipment will remain at the work location during all hours, working and non-working.
- 4. Marine radio frequency 16 should be monitored when in the vicinity of the construction site.
- 5. Navigators, please note the location and duration of this work and use caution in and around the area.
