Corps of Engineers hosts Industry Day program highlighting military construction and Army transformation initiatives at Fort Bliss

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will sponsor a site-specific Industry Day Jan. 18, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., at the El Paso Community College, Administrative Service Center located at 9050 Viscount Blvd. North El Paso, Texas 79925. The program will provide updated information on the procurement and execution of the Military Construction Program as it relates to Fort Bliss, Texas.

The MILCON program will consist of multiple facilities for the Army at Fort Bliss for company, battalion and brigade level barracks, operations buildings, tactical equipment shops, general instruction buildings and dining facilities. In addition, multiple facilities for families such as child development centers and fitness facilities will also be built to support the Army's transformation.

The Industry Day program will include presentations with question and answer periods to include the following topics: Overview of the Fort Bliss program; product-line approach and set asides under the authorized socio-economic categories for small businesses, Department of Army Mentor-Protégé program – 8(a) – Small Disadvantaged Business Program, Small Business Administration Mentor – Protégé program – Joint Venture program, Department of the Army Historically Underutilized Business Zone program, Small Business Administration HUB Zone program, Department of the Army Service Disabled-Veteran owned program and How to prepare a Best Value Proposal.
