U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announce Record of Decision on Central City Project

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District, announced today the signing of the Record of Decision for the Trinity River Central City Project by the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works, Mr. John Paul Woodley, Jr. This document is a milestone for the project as it closes out the National Environmental Policy Act process. The \$435 million project, which addresses four main objectives including flood protection, ecosystem improvements, urban revitalization and recreation, has been determined by the Secretary to be technically sound and environmentally acceptable.

"Working with our partners, we have demonstrated that a collaborative approach can achieve a better solution. This project achieves a number of important local and regional goals while protecting and enhancing the performance of existing public water resources infrastructure," said Col. John R. Minahan, district commander. "After years of public meetings, inputs from numerous local, state and federal agencies, this is a great day to move forward with Central City for the City of Fort Worth, Texas and the Nation."
