# STRATEGIC SOURCING DIRECTORS BOARD CHARTER

#### I. PURPOSE

The Strategic Sourcing Directors Board (SSDB) is the principal forum for monitoring and improving the DoD-Wide Strategic Sourcing (DWSS) Program.

#### The Board:

- Facilitates collaboration to support strategic sourcing across the Department of Defense (DoD) in support of the warfighters by creating cost savings, process improvements, and to achieve increased socioeconomic participation;
- Develops recommendations for DoD senior leadership on strategic sourcing initiatives;
- Shares ideas, best practices, lessons learned, and innovative approaches;
- Furthers the education and training of the Defense Acquisition workforce in the objectives, implementation, and management of strategic sourcing; and
- Develops strategic sourcing acquisition policies as needed.

# II. BACKGROUND/REFERENCES

#### III. MEMBERSHIP

The Deputy Director, DPAP/SS, serves as the SSDB Chair on behalf of the Director, DPAP.

- Primary membership to the Board is comprised of representatives from the following components, appointed by their Senior Procurement Executive (SPE) or Director:
  - o Department of the Air Force;
  - o Department of the Army;
  - o Department of the Navy;
  - o Defense Logistics Agency; and
  - o Defense Contract Management Agency.

- Board Advisors are comprised of, but not limited to, representatives from the following activities as appointed by their Leadership:
  - o Air Force Program Executive Officer for Combat Mission;
  - o Defense Acquisition University;
  - o Defense Information Systems Agency;
  - o Department of Defense Chief Information Officer;
  - o Naval Supply Systems Command;
  - o Office of Small Business Programs;
  - o TRICARE Management Activity;
  - o United States Marine Corps; and
  - o United States Transportation Command.

#### IV. SSDB MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

The SSDB serves as the primary governing body for the DWSS program. The Board provides strategic vision, guidance, and direction that enables and promotes strategic sourcing, to include the drafting and implementation of the Strategic Plans for the Strategic Sourcing of Goods and Services. Members and Advisors of the SSDB are instrumental and shall bring forward observations and recommendations to further enterprise-wide strategic sourcing. Members shall strive to attend all meetings. Specific responsibilities are listed below.

- The SSDB Chair is responsible for:
  - o Scheduling and presiding over SSDB meetings;
  - o Providing primary SSDB representation at Federal Strategic Sourcing Initiative (FSSI) Meetings and at Strategic Sourcing Working Group (SSWG) Meetings;
  - Inviting SSDB Advisors to meetings;
  - Supplying administrative support during meetings, to include minutes, agendas, and action item statuses;
  - o Distributing annual spend analyses on services and goods;
  - Maintaining and updating the Strategic Plans for the Strategic Sourcing of Services and Goods; and
  - o Submitting the annual DoD Report on Strategic Sourcing Initiatives, with SSDB coordination, to the USD(AT&L), who in turn submits to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB).
- The SSDB Primary Members are responsible for:
  - o Representing their respective Service/Agency as a focal point for strategic sourcing;
  - o Assuming responsibility for the Strategic Sourcing Strategic Plans mission, vision, and goals;

- o Providing working level representation at FSSI and SSWG meetings;
- o Submitting their respective annual Reports on Strategic Sourcing Initiatives to the Deputy Director, DPAP/SS;
- Communicating strategic sourcing initiatives to their organizations and key stakeholders; and
- o Providing support to SSDB chartered working groups.
- The SSDB Advisors are responsible for:
  - o Representing their respective Service/Agency as a focal point for strategic sourcing;
  - o Communicating strategic sourcing initiatives to their organizations and key stakeholders; and
  - o Providing support to SSDB chartered working groups.

### V. MEETING PROCEDURES

Meetings shall occur as called by the Chair or Board Members. Regular meetings will occur approximately every six weeks.

#### VI. WORKING GROUPS

The Board may use working groups to address particular issues and initiatives, as needed. Working groups consist of Board Members and/or Advisors to effectively address issues and initiatives. Progress and outcomes of working groups are reported to the SSDB for action.

#### VII. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Charter is effective upon signature of all Parties. This Charter may be changed/modified only by majority consent of all Parties.
