Colonel Anne M. Moisan is Chief of Staff for the INSS Research Directorate. She is also a member of the Research Directorate's Europe Team, focusing on European security, NATO and political-military issues. She assumed these duties in February 2003.

Col Moisan is a Joint Specialty Officer with extensive line, staff and command experience in international political-military affairs, logistics, and recruiting fields. Her most recent duty prior to joining INSS was as Assistant Director of NATO Policy within the Office of the Secretary of Defense. Before that assignment, she was a student at the National War College: Deputy Director of the Secretary of the Air Force's Action Group at the Pentagon; Commander of the 317th Recruiting Squadron at Andrews AFB; and International Strategic Programs Analyst at Headquarters, US European Command in Stuttgart, Germany. COL Moisan has also served globally in a variety of USAF and unified commands: Pacific Air Forces, US Air Forces in Europe, Tactical Air Command. Air Force Logistics Command. Military Airlift Command, Air Force Space Command, Air Force Recruiting Service, North American Air Defense Command and US European Command. Her career encompasses eight years of overseas service, including two assignments in Germany and remote tours in Iceland and Diego Garcia.

In 1976, Col Moisan graduated with a BS in International Economics from the Edmund Walsh School of Foreign Service at Georgetown University. She was subsequently commissioned as a second lieutenant in the US Air Force in 1978. Colonel Moisan also holds three graduate degrees: MBA, Golden Gate University; MA, International Affairs, University of Oklahoma; MS, National Security Strategy, National Defense University.

Col Moisan's awards and decorations include the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Air Force Meritorious Service Medal, Air Force Commendation Medal and the Air Force Achievement Medal.
