Access to our solicitations is changing!

Effective February 15, 2006, USACE was directed to discontinue use of the Electronic Bid System (EBS) used by the Corps of Engineers for the last several years. We have begun posting our solicitations and documents to the secure Federal Technical Data System (FedTeDS) servers. Potential offerors, plan rooms and printing companies will be required to register in both CCR and FedTeDS systems to view or download solicitations. **The Fort Worth District will no longer routinely furnish CD's of our solicitations.**

We have now implemented a system to provide the basic information that was contained in the EBS. You may obtain information about jobs by clicking on the Advertised Solicitation link on our home page. From that page you will be able to see the Solicitation Number, Title, Location, District, Issue Date and Closing Date of jobs we have on the street. Clicking on a solicitation number will take you to a page that gives you the name and phone number of the Contract Specialist handling the project, a description of the job, and a link to a **plan holder's list**. You will NOT be able to download plans from this site. However, we do provide a link to the file on FedTeDS (you must be registered with FedTeDS to download files).

Contractors are encouraged to continue monitoring FBO to determine what work is upcoming and when it will be issued. They will also have to monitor FBO for any changes to the solicitations. Finding our Solicitations

Once on the Fed Biz Opps website, click the "GO" button beside **★ Find Business Opportunities** at the top left side of the screen. From this page you can perform a search in many ways to locate any available government solicitation. To find an available solicitation for the Fort Worth District follow the steps below.

- In the block titled "Full Text Search", type "W9126G".
- Click on "Start Search".
- View the list of projects.
- When you find the solicitation you are looking for, click the project title.
- On the following screen, click "Technical Data Package".
- On the next screen, click the link that reads "Available via the FedTeDS website".

This link takes you to the FedTeDS website. You must login using the Username and Password that were created or assigned during your FedTeDS registration. Steps for downloading the technical data package are available in the FedTeDS Vendor User Guide on their website (www.fedteds.gov).
