

PICKENSVILLE RECREATION AREA

Pickensville Recreation Area is operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and is located in Pickens County, Alabama on the East Bank of the Tennessee-Tombigbee, just off of AL Highway 86 at Pickensville. Facilities include fishing piers, a fish cleaning station, restrooms, a volleyball court, white sand beach, a boat ramp and two large covered shelters. Other single uncovered picnic tables with grills are also available. Gates open at 6 a.m. For more information about the park, call (205) 373-8820 or (205) 373-8705.
