S.W. Taylor Overlook is operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and is located in Pickens County, Alabama on the West Bank of Tennessee-Tombigbee, off of AL Highway 17, just off of Pickens/Sumter County Road 85. Facilities include a covered shelter at S.W. Taylor Overlook and a beautiful view of the old Tombigbee River. This area is closed during the winter months.
