

WAVERLY RECREATION AREA

Waverly Recreation Area is operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and is located in Clay County, Mississippi on the West Bank of the Tennessee-Tombigbee, just off of MS Highway 50, between Columbus and West Point, Mississippi. Facilities include restrooms, a boat ramp, play area and two large covered shelters. Other single uncovered picnic tables with grills are also available. Gates to the picnic area open at 6 a.m. For more information about the park, call (662) 494-0039 or (662) 327-2142. Park Hosts are available if assistance is needed.
