

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers hosts special hog hunting opportunity at Lavon Lake

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Lavon Lake, announced today that a special hog hunting opportunity will open Jan. 25, 2008 and run through April 30. Permit applications will be accepted in person from Dec. 17, 2007 – Jan. 17, 2008 at the lake office. Applicant selection will be by random computer drawing on Jan. 18, 2008. The hunting area will be divided into sections of approximately 400-600 acres and permitted hunters will have access to these areas. Certain special harvest methods will be allowed. This hunting opportunity is being held to help reduce the population of hogs around the lake. Federal and state hunting laws will apply.
