Corps of Engineers to conduct routine inspection of Cooper Dam Stilling Basin

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District will conduct a routine inspection of Cooper Dam Stilling Basin June 16 – 20. During the inspection the stilling basin road will be closed to the public for safety and security reasons.

The routine inspection will cover the stilling basin and outflow structure. All work conducted during this inspection period will be completed with environmental safeguards in place to protect the Sulphur River basin and its fisheries.
