Corps Announces Camp Bowie Public Meeting

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will be holding a public meeting to discuss upcoming ordnance investigation on the former Camp Bowie installation. The meeting will be held Thursday, February 3, beginning at 7:00 p.m., Adams Street Community Center, 510 E. Adams St., Brownwood, TX., 76801. The investigation is designed to determine the presence and extent of ordnance and explosive items remaining in the former camp area and to make recommendations for future actions based on the results.

Property owners of the former Camp Bowie are encouraged to attend the meeting and bring forward any questions they may have concerning the project, field investigation or Rights-of-Entry. The investigation is being conducted as part of the Corps' Formerly Used Defense Sites (FUDS) Program.
