Benbrook Lake Eagle Mountain Easement Environmental Assessment

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) and a draft Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) regarding the proposed easement for the Eagle Mountain Connection at Benbrook Lake, Texas.

The proposed action is for the Corps of Engineers to grant a 90-foot easement to Tarrant Regional Water District so that they can construct a portion of their proposed project on federal property. This would include an easement for a 96-inch pipeline and a booster pump station facility with water tanks. It would also be wide enough to include an additional 96-inch pipeline in the future. The other actions considered in the EA include the no action alternative and one other alternate route.

An EA and draft FONSI for the proposed action were prepared in accordance with the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and Engineering Regulation 200-2-2, Procedures for Implementing NEPA. The EA was drafted to identify and evaluate the environmental aspects of implementing the proposed action in accordance with NEPA.
