Trinity Uptown/Central City Project to Impact Tarrant County Residents

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and local sponsors will host an open house with public input meetings concerning the draft Environmental Impact Statement on the Trinity Uptown/Central City Project on July 26 and 27. The meetings will be held at the YWCA in downtown Fort Worth, 512 West 4th Street, beginning at 4 p.m. each day. Parking is free after 6 p.m. in the parking lot across from the YWCA on Burnett Street and at city parking meters.

Representatives from the City of Fort Worth, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Tarrant Regional Water District, and Streams and Valleys, Inc., will be on hand to explain and answer questions about the Trinity River Vision, the Central City Project, and the proposed Trinity Uptown. Informational kiosks will be staffed from 4 to 7 p.m. which will include information on all aspects of the proposed development north of downtown Fort Worth, including infrastructure, flood protection, environmental issues, recreational opportunities, funding, cultural and historical aspects.

Public comments will be recorded during the open house or during the formal comment period beginning at 7 p.m. each evening. A Spanish translator will be available during the meetings.
