

# "On January 15, 2009, Your TV is Changing. Are You Ready?"

On February 17, 2009 analog broadcasting will end for full-power TV stations.

This will affect you if you watch free over-the-air programming with rabbit ear or rooftop antenna.

If you have a TV with a digital tuner, you can already receive digital broadcasts. Or, if your TV is connected to a paid service like cable or satellite, digital broadcasting should have no effect on your service. If you have any questions, call your provider.

But, if you have an analog TV with rabbit ears or rooftop antenna, you need to act:

1

Connect your analog TV to a digital-to-analog converter box. **Or**

2

Buy a digital television (a TV with a built-in-analog converter box, **Or**

3

Subscribe to a paid TV service (such as cable or satellite TV).
