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## **ACTIVITY: FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES**

### **Suggestions for Presenters**

1. Divide the participants into small groups, with five to seven members each. Ask the participants to come up with four or five possible funding streams that may be used to fund the project/partnership.
2. Use a flip chart to record the responses from each of the groups. Combine answers and eliminate duplications.
3. Have the group review the list and add any additional items.
4. Use the list to begin analyzing what additional funding streams may be used to support the project/partnership.

- Easel, flip chart paper and markers
