SUBJECT: Mandatory Training for Purchases Made Through the National Aeronautics
and Space Administration (NASA) Scientific & Engineering Workstation
Procurement (SEWP) IV

The DoD IG, in collaboration with the NASA IG, recently completed an audit of DoD procurements made through the NASA SEWP contract. The report includes recommendations on how DoD can best utilize this acquisition vehicle. The DoD IG recommends DoD to require users of the NASA SEWP contracts to take free training provided by NASA. The Department concurs with this recommendation. Effective when the NASA SEWP IV is awarded, only a warranted DoD contracting officer or a purchase card holder who has completed the free training and received a certificate of training completion can place an order on the NASA SEWP IV contract. NASA will maintain the list of contracting officers that have completed the training.

The report additionally recommended that contracting officers should seek discounts when awarding orders and to routinely utilize SEWP's on-line RFQ tool. You are highly encouraged to seek discounts when using SEWP to obtain the best possible price. Additionally, you are highly encouraged to utilize the SEWP On-line RFQ tool, especially since it includes prompts to ensure that the requirements for "Fair Opportunity" are met.
