Appropriations:

- Read Act Language
- Special Instructions in Conference Report
- Special Instructions in Senate and House Reports
- Read Congressional Record
- Reconcile Differences
 - Act Governs
 - Conference Report Governs Over House and Senate Reports
 - Report Language not in Disagreement

Document Use (Continued)

Project Authorizations:

- Note Citations in Act...
 e.g., "as Recommended in the Report of the Chief of Engineers Dated..."
- Check Report of the Chief of Engineers and Recommendations of ASA(CW)/Chief/Division/District
- Check Reports of...
 - Conference/Senate/House for Possible Discussion and Clarification of:
 - Special Projects
 - General Authorities
 - Clarification or Guidance Sometimes in Hearings Record or Floor Colloquies
