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## CEMENT IN SEPTEMBER 2008

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers, and the production of clinker, in the United States from January 2007 through the current month.<sup>1</sup> The current report contains extensive revisions to the data for, primarily, northern California and Puerto Rico. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for the current month are also provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for September 2008 were about 8.8 million metric tons (Mt). This was about 10% lower than shipments in September 2007 (tables 2A and 2B). Year-to-date shipments were 74.8 Mt, down by about 13% from those of the same period in 2007. The leading producing States (Texas, California, Michigan, Missouri, and Pennsylvania, in descending order) shipped about 36% of the September total (table 1A). The leading consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Illinois, and Ohio, in descending order) received about 34% of September's total shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Clinker production totaled about 7.1 Mt, about 5% lower than the production in September 2007 (table 4). Year-to-date production was 60.7 Mt, down by about 7% compared with that

of the same period in 2007. The leading clinker-producing States (Texas, California, Florida, Missouri, and Pennsylvania, in descending order) produced about 44% of the September total.

Masonry cement shipments in September of about 266,000 metric tons were about 21% lower than shipments for September 2007 (table 2C). Year-to-date shipments were 2.44 Mt, down by about 28% from those of the same period in 2007. The leading consuming States in September, in descending order, were Florida, California, Texas, North Carolina, and Georgia, and these States received about 46% of September's total shipments.

Tables 5, 6, and 7 contain import data from the U.S. Census Bureau. Data for clinker imports into the Seattle and possibly the Detroit customs districts are likely incomplete owing to some shipments arriving overland from Canada on an informal entry basis. September 2008 imports of cement and clinker were about 0.8 Mt, down by about 58% from imports in September 2007. Year-to-date imports were 9.2 Mt, down by about 49%.
