DIRECTORY OF PRINCIPAL CONSTRUCTION AGGREGATES PRODUCERS IN THE UNITED STATES IN 2006

A total of 3.04 billion metric tons of construction aggregates valued at \$22.4 billion, free on board at plant, was reported produced in the United States in 2006 by 4,895 companies with 9,522 operations, 3,379 active quarries, and 8,205 active pits. A total of 283 sales yards were operated by 86 companies.

The 10 leading producing States were, in descending order of tonnage, Texas, California, Florida, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Illinois, Arizona, Georgia, Missouri, and North Carolina, which accounted for 45% of the total output of construction aggregates.

The 10 companies listed in table 1, with a total of 837 active quarries and 609 active pits, accounted for 36% of the total output of construction aggregates in the United States. In addition, these companies operated 194 sales/distribution yards. The companies listed in table 1 are not included in table 2 when the company is not a leading producer in a given State.
