Problem/Issue:

User wants to access email across the Internet and needs to set HTTP Password.

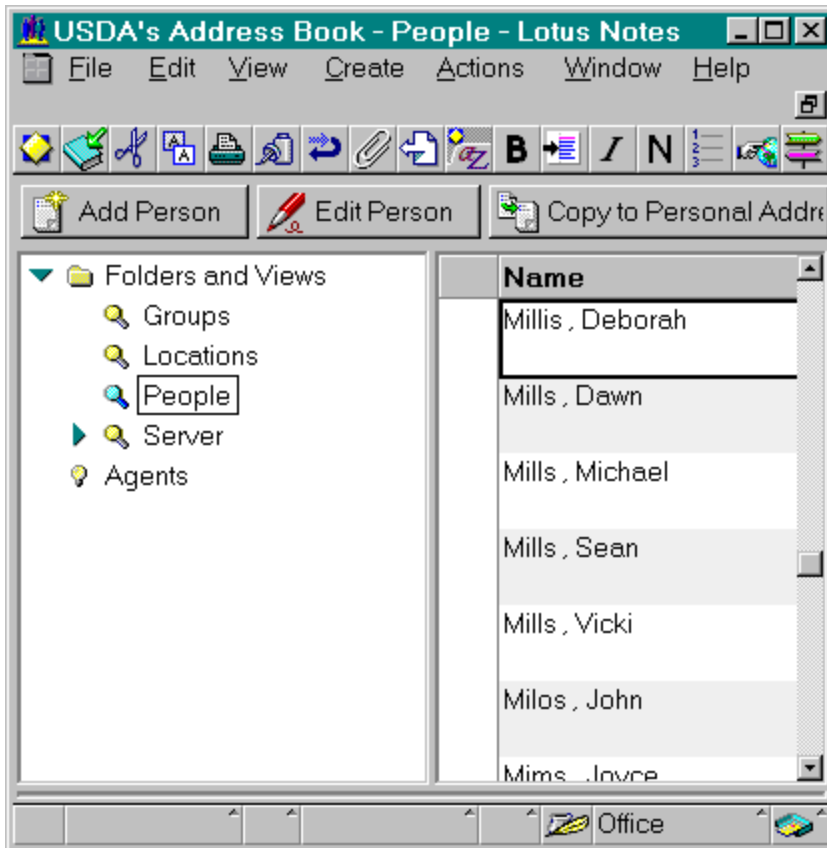
Solution:

HTTP password must be set in the Person Record in the USDA Address Book on the Server. See the Additional Info for detailed instructions.

Additional Info:

Before you begin, you must be connected either through the Network or through an RLD dialup connection.

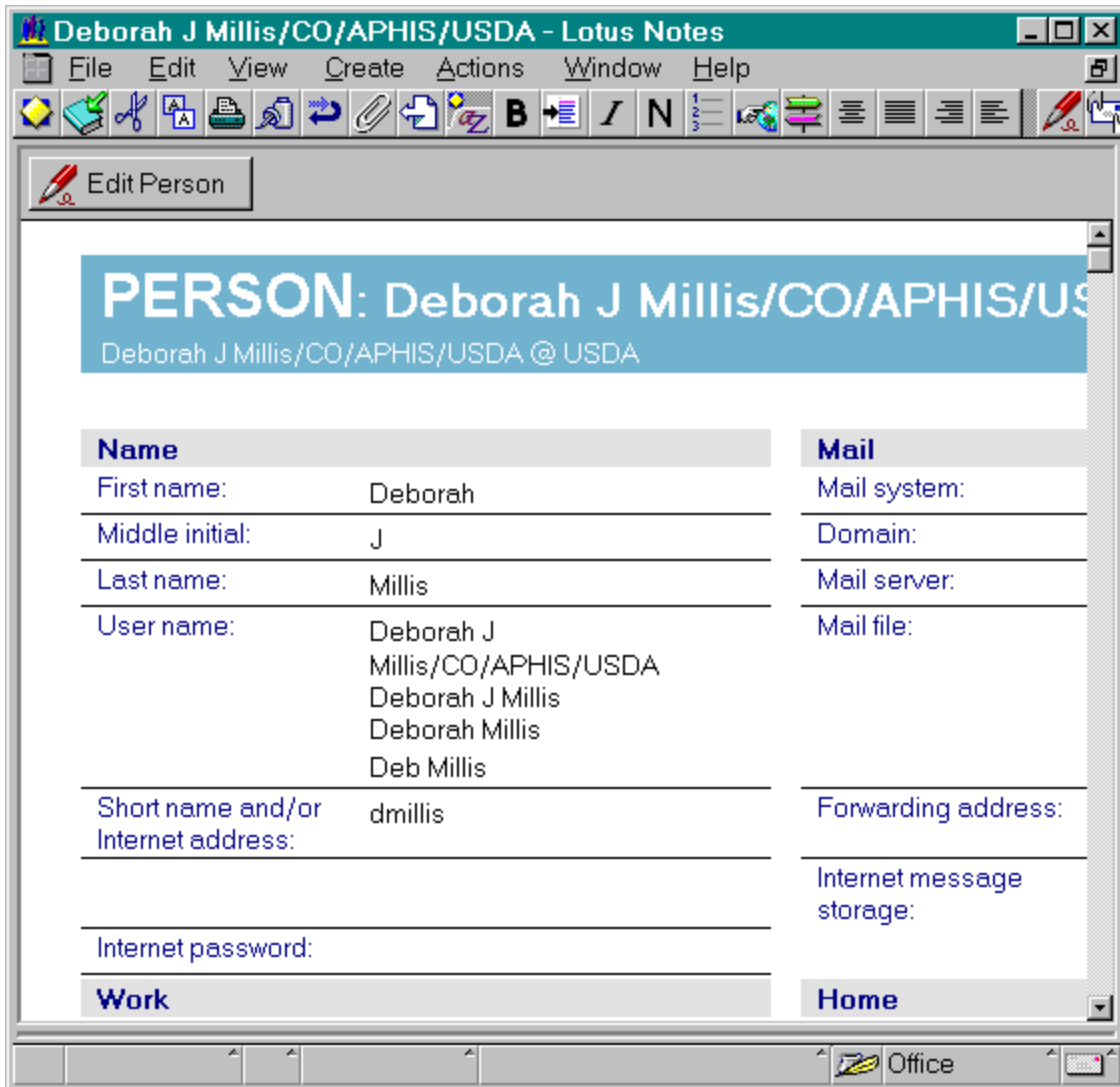
- Double click on the USDA Address Book on Mail01 (or Mail02, Mail03, or Mail04) .
- On the Left side of the screen (the Navigation Pane), make sure the People view is highlighted by clicking on it.



- Click on the Right side, and begin typing your last name to activate the automatic search feature and click OK.



- Double click on your name to open your Person Record.



- Click on the Edit Person button to enter an Edit Mode.
- In the field, Internet password: type a password that you can remember.

You will use this password when accessing the Notes Server from the internet and it is important that it be a password you can remember.

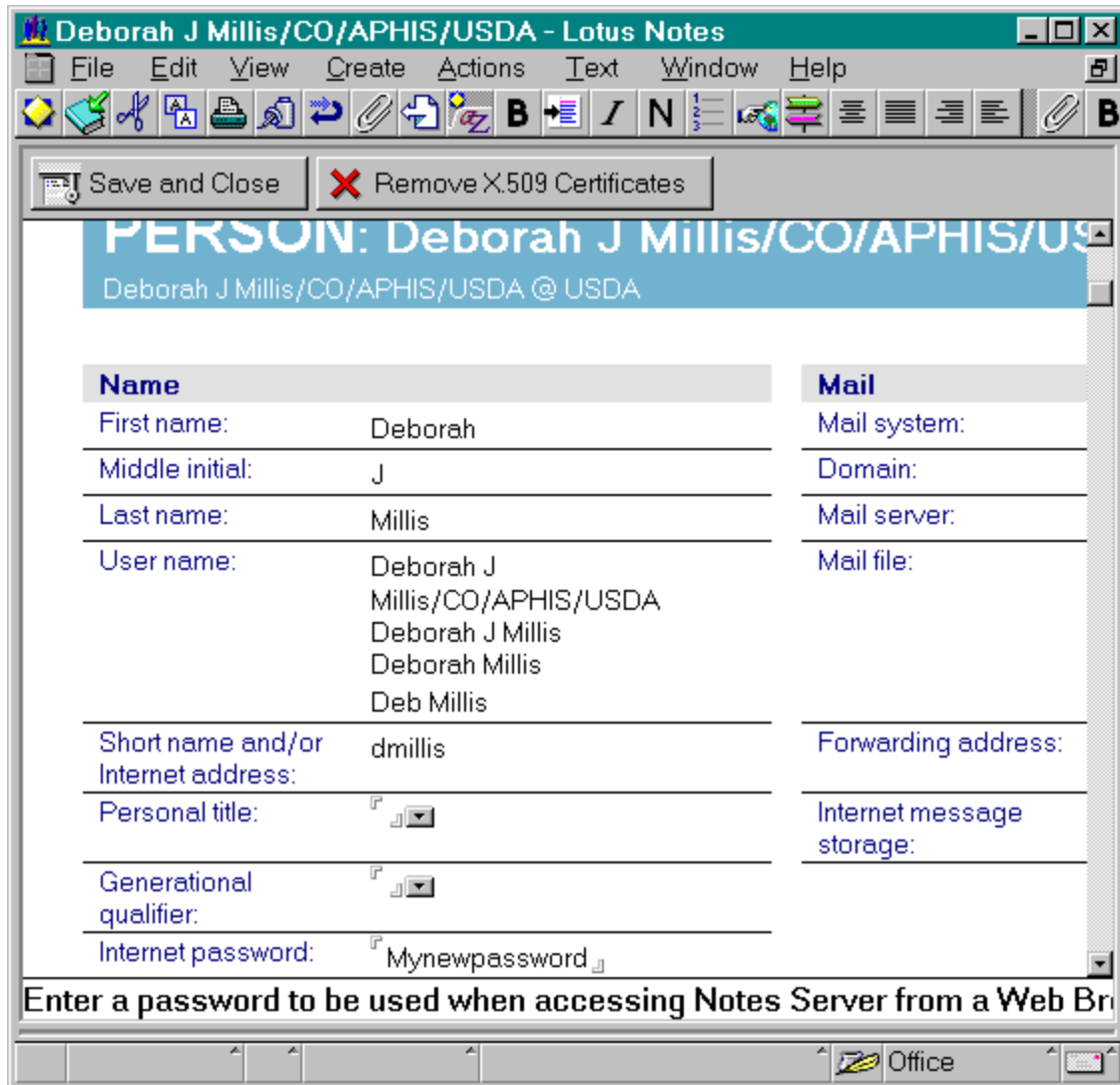
