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GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. PURPOSE. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MESSAGE IS TO
PROMULGATE POLICY FOR UNIFORM ACTIVE DIRECTORY NAMING CONVENTIONS
AND GAL DISPLAY NAMING STANDARDS THROUGHOUT THE MARINE CORPS.

2. CANCELLATION. THIS MESSAGE SUPERCEDES AND CANCELS REFS J, K, L,
AND M.

3. BACKGROUND. AS THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE (DOD)TRANSITIONS TO
COMMON INTEROPERABLE COMPUTER SERVICES AND SYSTEMS, IT IS NECESSARY
TO STANDARDIZE USER ACCOUNT INFORMATION, SUCH AS EMAIL ADDRESS,
RANK, PHONE NUMBER, ADDRESS, COMPONENT, ETC., IN ORDER TO CLEARLY
IDENTIFY INDIVIDUALS FOR PURPOSES OF CORRESPONDENCE AND ASSIGNING
PERMISSIONS TO APPLICATIONS, WEBSITES, AND OTHER INFORMATION STORES
ON THE VARIOUS DOD NETWORKS. THIS STANDARDIZED USER INFORMATION
WILL ALSO POPULATE THE JOINT ENTERPRISE DIRECTORY SERVICE (JEDS),
WHICH IS ESSENTIALLY A GAL FOR THE ENTIRE DOD. THEREFORE, IT IS
IMPERATIVE THAT ADHERENCE TO A STANDARD FORMAT FOR USER ACCOUNT
INFORMATION IS MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE MARINE CORPS. IT ALSO

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IS UNLIMITED.

FOLLOWS THAT USER ACCOUNT INFORMATION MUST BE ACCURATE, COMPREHENSIVE AND KEPT UP TO DATE.

4. ACTION. THE FOLLOWING IS THE MANDATED STANDARD FOR ALL ACTIVE DIRECTORY (USER ACCOUNT) ATTRIBUTES (E.G. EMAIL ADDRESS, GAL DISPLAY NAME, EMPLOYEE TYPE, ETC) FOR ALL MARINE CORPS ENTERPRISE NETWORK (MCEN) ACCOUNTS ON THE NIPRNET AND SIPRNET.

A. USE OF PAY GRADE TO IDENTIFY GOVERNMENT CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES IN THE GAL DISPLAY NAME IS NO LONGER AUTHORIZED. IAW REF F, ALL GOVERNMENT CIVILIAN PERSONNEL WILL HAVE THE CIV VALUE PLACED IN THE EMPLOYEE TYPE FIELD OF THE GAL DISPLAY NAME ATTRIBUTE.

B. IAW REF F, ALL CONTRACTORS WILL HAVE THE CTR VALUE PLACED IN THEIR EMPLOYEE TYPE ATTRIBUTE AND GAL DISPLAY NAME ATTRIBUTE.

C. THE MCEN DESIGNATED ACCREDITING AUTHORITY (DAA) HAS AUTHORIZED THE USE OF THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL VALUES FOR THE EMPLOYEE TYPE OR RANK/TITLE ATTRIBUTE FOR USE WITHIN THE MCEN FOR MILITARY AND GOVERNMENT CIVILIAN PERSONNEL, WHERE APPLICABLE. THESE VALUES MAY REPLACE THE CIV OR MILITARY RANK VALUE IN THE DISPLAY NAME:

(1) SES SENIOR EXECUTIVE SERVICE (OPTIONAL IN PLACE OF CIV)
(2) SL SENIOR LEADER (OPTIONAL IN PLACE OF CIV. SL IS AN SES EQUIVALENT)

(3) DR - PHD INSTRUCTOR SUPPORTING MARINE CORPS PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION (OPTIONAL IN PLACE OF CIV)

(4) SPA - PERSONNEL HOLDING THE BILLET OF SPECIAL AGENT (OPTIONAL IN PLACE OF CIV OR MILITARY RANK)

(5) INV PERSONNEL HOLDING THE BILLET OF INVESTIGATOR (OPTIONAL IN PLACE OF CIV OR MILITARY RANK)

D. ADDITIONAL BASELINE USER ATTRIBUTE VALUES WILL BE STANDARDIZED IAW REF F, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED IN THIS POLICY.

E. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS POLICY, FOREIGN NATIONAL (FN) REFERS TO ALL INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE NON-U.S. CITIZENS INCLUDING U.S. MILITARY PERSONNEL, DOD CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES AND CONTRACTORS. FOREIGN NATIONAL STATUS MUST BE CLEARLY DISPLAYED IN ALL WRITTEN OR ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS. COUNTRY CODE DESIGNATIONS FOR FOREIGN NATIONALITY CAN BE FOUND IN REF A.

F. GAL DISPLAY NAME CONVENTION: LASTNAME<SPACE>RANK/TITLE OR EMPLOYEE TYPE<SPACE>FIRSTNAME <SPACE>MIDDLE INITIAL<SPACE>GENERATIONAL QUALIFIER<SPACE>COUNTRY OF CITIZENSHIP (2 DIGIT COUNTRY CODE) (IF FOREIGN NATIONAL).

(1) ALL WORDS AND APPROPRIATE ABBREVIATIONS WILL BE IN NORMAL CASE, I.E., THE FIRST LETTER WILL BE UPPER CASE AND REMAINING LETTERS WILL BE IN LOWER CASE. INITIALS OR ACRONYMS WILL BE IN ALL UPPER CASE. NO PERIODS, COMMAS, APOSTROPHES, OR HYPHENS SHALL BE USED.

EXAMPLES: SMITH MSGT JOE D, JONES CIV DAVE E III, DOE CTR JANE E II UK.

(2) THE RANK/TITLE ATTRIBUTE WILL BE USED FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL. THE EMPLOYEE TYPE ATTRIBUTE WILL BE USED FOR ALL OTHER EMPLOYEE TYPES (E.G. CIVILIAN PERSONNEL, CONTRACTORS, RETIREES, VOLUNTEERS).

G. NIPRNET EMAIL ADDRESS NAMING CONVENTION:

(1) EMAIL ADDRESSES WILL BE ALL LOWER CASE.

(2) FOR CONTRACTORS: FIRSTNAME.LASTNAME.CTR@UNIT(FOR NON-NMCI ACCOUNTS).USMC.MIL.

EXAMPLES: (NMCI) JOE.SMITH.CTR@USMC.MIL; (NON NMCI) JOE.SMITH.CTR@MCNOSC.USMC.MIL.

(3) FOREIGN NATIONALS: FIRSTNAME.LASTNAME.2 DIGIT COUNTRY CODE@UNIT(FOR NON-NMCI ACCOUNTS).USMC.MIL.

EXAMPLES: (NMCI) JOE.SMITH.JA@USMC.MIL; (NON NMCI) JOE.SMITH.JA@MCNOSC.USMC.MIL.

(4) FOR CONTRACTORS THAT ARE FOREIGN NATIONALS: FIRSTNAME.LASTNAME.CTR.2 DIGIT COUNTRY CODE@UNIT(FOR NON-NMCI ACCOUNTS).USMC.MIL.

EXAMPLES: (NMCI) JOE.SMITH.CTR.TW@USMC.MIL; (NON NMCI)

JOE.SMITH.CTR.TW@MCNOSC.USMC.MIL.

(5) ALL OTHERS: FIRSTNAME.LASTNAME@UNIT(FOR NON-NMCI ACCOUNTS).USMC.MIL.

EXAMPLES: (NMCI) JOE.SMITH@USMC.MIL; (NON NMCI) JOE.SMITH@MCNOSC.USMC.MIL.

(6) DUPLICATE NAMES:

(A) FIRST DUPLICATE REMEDIATION ATTEMPT WILL BE TO ADD THE MIDDLE INITIAL.

EXAMPLE: JOE.J.SMITH

(B) FINAL DUPLICATE REMEDIATION ATTEMPT WILL BE TO ASSIGN A NUMBER TO THE END OF THE LAST NAME OF THE USER.

EXAMPLE: JOE.J.SMITH2

H. SIPRNET EMAIL ADDRESS NAMING CONVENTION WILL FOLLOW THE FORMAT DETAILED IN PARAGRAPH 4.F., WITH THE ADDITION OF .SMIL PRIOR TO .MIL.

EXAMPLE: JOE.J.SMITH2.CTR@MCNOSC.USMC.SMIL.MIL.

I. HQMC C4 INITIATE AN ENTERPRISE MOVE/ADD/CHANGE TO TRANSITION ALL GOVERNMENT CIVILIAN MARINE CORPS NMCI ACCOUNTS (EXCLUDING THOSE EXCEPTIONS IDENTIFIED IN PARAGRAPH 4.C.) FROM PAY GRADE TO CIV IN THE GAL DISPLAY NAME.

J. COMMANDS WILL ENSURE THAT ALL EMAIL ACCOUNTS CONFORM TO THE STANDARDS LISTED IN THIS DIRECTIVE.

K. COMPLIANCE WITH THIS DIRECTIVE MUST BE ACCOMPLISHED NLT 90 DAYS FROM THE RELEASE OF THIS MESSAGE. EMAIL ACCOUNTS THAT ARE NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THIS DIRECTIVE WILL BE DISABLED UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THEY BECOME COMPLIANT.

L. INDIVIDUAL ACCOUNT HOLDERS WILL ENSURE THAT GAL INFORMATION IS ACCURATE FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE ACCOUNT. INFORMATION FOUND TO BE INACCURATE MUST BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF IT SUPPORT PERSONNEL FOR CORRECTION/CHANGE.

M. REQUESTS FOR EXCEPTION TO THIS POLICY WILL BE ADDRESSED ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS. REQUESTS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE MCEN DAA, AND CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(1). REQUESTED DEVIATION TO ESTABLISHED POLICIES OR IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE.

(2). SPECIFIC JUSTIFICATION ADDRESSING WHY THE REQUIREMENT IS MISSION CRITICAL.

N. ESTIMATED NUMBERS OF PERSONNEL AFFECTED BY THE DEVIATION.

O. POINT OF CONTACT INFORMATION.
