

PQRI Patient-Level Measures

Requiring Only One-Time Reporting Per Eligible Patient Reference List

The following list is a subset of the 2008 measures for which the reporting frequency is a minimum of once per eligible patient during the reporting period (January 1 - December 31, 2008) for each eligible professional (NPI).

These measures require only one encounter per eligible patient to be reported per eligible professional. Physicians who have not yet started reporting may want to consider this list of measures first when selecting which measures to report for 2008.
